

Guidelines for Re-enactors Participating in the July 9th, 2016 Capitol Event

*All participants will register when checking in to the event and fill out a release form. Those not filling out a form will not be able to participate.

*Display tables or demonstrations can be set up and are encouraged, with prior approval from Save the Flags Committee.

*NO TENT STAKES are allowed on the Capitol grounds. If you want to put up a tent or fly please fasten your ropes to a bucket of sand/cement.

*No participant above the rank of Captain without prior approval of the Save the Flags Committee.

*No unauthorized or unscheduled discharge of firearms at any time without prior approval of the Save the Flags Committee.

*Troops will be mustered on the northwest side of the Capitol building beginning at 12:30. Please be prompt.

*The ceremony will begin at 1pm. The troops will line up and march in along the sidewalk on the north side of the Capitol, to Capitol Avenue, then will turn to march up to the Capitol steps.

*The ceremony will begin at 1pm. After the National Anthem troops will be ordered to stack arms and then "rest." You will be free to take a seat, sit with your family/friends, etc until the troops are called back to assemble. Volunteers will be asked to keep watch over the arms/flags during the ceremony.

*After the closing remarks the troops firing a volley will be moved to a designated area for safety. Following the infantry volley, the artillery batteries will fire, followed by 'taps'.

*Parking for reenactors will be available in the lot directly behind the Capitol, entrance off Allegan Street or on any city street free of charge.
